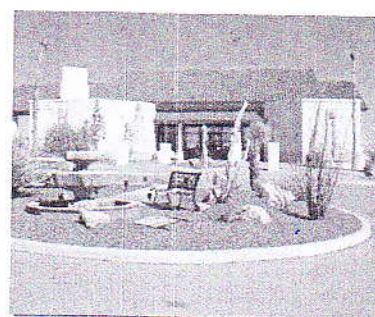

FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

At it's May Board of Directors meeting the Board awarded contracts for several items listed to be repaired during 2018 by the Reserve Study.

First, the iron fence and light poles to be sanded and repainted. This work has been completed.

Second, resurfacing of the pool deck. This work has not been scheduled as yet but once it is, it will require closing of the pool and pool area for four to five days.
